

In 1887, the Colorado & Wyoming Railroad, a subsidiary of the Chicago, Burlington & Quincy Railroad, completed a line connecting Dewitt, Nebraska (east of map area) to Cheyenne, Wyoming. The section from Sterling, Colorado (east of map area) to Cheyenne was abandoned in the 1970's.

The C&W grade near Buckingham, Colorado, is now a linear berm blanketed in the same grass as the surrounding rolling plains.
